

# Girl's Clothing List

## YEARS 7 - 11

School uniform should be worn and a smart appearance is expected at all times. This means shirts should be tucked in, skirts are of an appropriate length - not rolled up and not mid-thigh length, no hoodies apart from when worn for sport. School shoes must be worn, no trainers.

### UNIFORM

- Blazer\*
- Skirt or grey trousers (x 2 for boarders)\*
- Green sweater\*
- White long or short sleeve blouse - not fitted, reverse collar (x 3 for boarders)
- Tights: black/skin colour (winter term)
- White ankle socks-not trainer socks (summer term)
- Black Leather 'normal school shoes' (not trainers, sneakers, suede or canvas, boots or Vans/Converse style)
- Coat – should be dark in colour (blue or black), solid colour, no trim, no fringes, no fur
- Science/Art overall

### OPTIONAL FOR LEISURE ONLY

- Green or grey leisure hoody\*
- Fleece lined jacket\*
- Scarf – green and purple

### SPORT AND ACTIVITIES KIT

- Black PE shirt\*
- Black zip neck mid layer\*

- Black PE/games skort or shorts\*
- White PE socks\*
- Green games socks\*
- Black tracksuit trousers\* (2 options available)
- Thirds polo shirt\* (to be purchased when Thirds are allocated at the start of term)
- Appropriate trainers
- Games bag\*

### COMPULSORY FOR HOCKEY

- Gum shield
- Shin pads

### OPTIONAL EXTRAS FOR SPORT

- Black base layer top. (base layer should only be worn underneath the games shirt)
- Black leggings. (leggings should only be worn underneath a skort or shorts)
- Black hoody\*
- Waterproof tracksuit top\*
- Netball dress - compulsory for netball team players only in Years 8-10. Dresses for Year 11 team players will be supplied by the school\*

### APPEARANCE STANDARDS

We have the same rules for boys and girls.

- **Hair** should be kept tidy. In years 7-9 long hair should be neatly tied back. Unnaturally coloured or excessively styled hair that draws attention to the wearer is not allowed. The Headmaster is the sole judge of this standard.
- **Jewellery** may not be worn apart from a watch and small, stud earrings – no hoops.
- **Make-up** is not allowed for girls in Years 7 – 9 and in Years 10 - 11 it must be worn discreetly. Only clear nail polish is allowed. Artificial nails/eye lashes are not allowed.

**NB: Parents and Guardians should ensure that all items of clothing are clearly and permanently marked with the pupil's name. Name labels are available to purchase from the school shop.**
